On behalf of our Founder and Executive Director Dayton Moore, thank you for your interest in becoming a mentor with our C-10 Mentoring & Leadership Program. Our mission at the “C” You In The Major Leagues Foundation is to provide hope and support to children and families as we use baseball to reach, teach, and develop future character-driven leaders. We feel this mentoring program is a great way to reach high school students with those messages of leadership, faith, and community service.

We launched C-10 in August 2018 with 10 high school students, mostly from underserved areas of greater Kansas City.
